THE EHCNA REQUEST

Parents/cares/school/college/ young person submit a request to the Local Authority.

This can be done in writing. The receipt of this written requested marks 'Day 1' of the EHCNA process.



YES/NO TO ISSUE A PLAN

Assessments take place and should be completed by week 16.

By this point the LA, by law, must tell you whether they intend to issue a plan for your child, or not.



FINAL PLAN

By week 20, the LA must have considered your amendments, consulted with settings, and issued you with a final plan which names a specific setting.

You have a right of appeal on sections B, F and I.



YES/NO TO ASSESS

The LA must respond within 6 weeks to let you know if they are going to proceed to the assessment stage.

If the LA's decision is no to assess, you have a right of appeal.

If the LA do not adhere to this deadline, you can explore a complaint/Pre Action Protocol (PAP) letter.

DRAFT PLAN

By week 17 you should receive a draft plan. You then have a minimum of 15 calendar days to make representations (amendments and your views) on the draft plan and set out your parental choice of placement.

It is usual for Section I to be blank at this stage.
